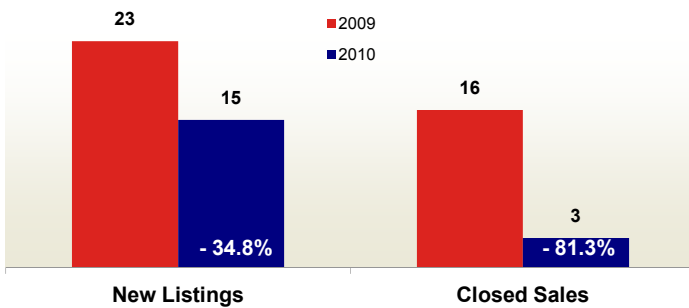

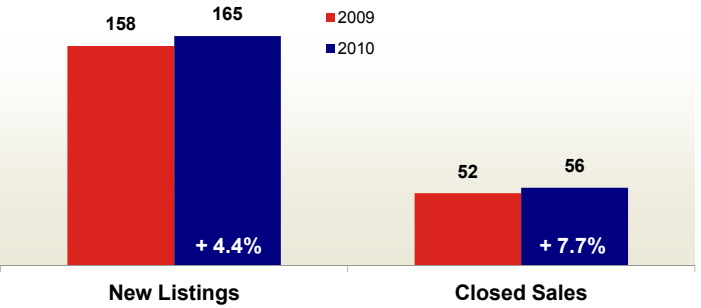

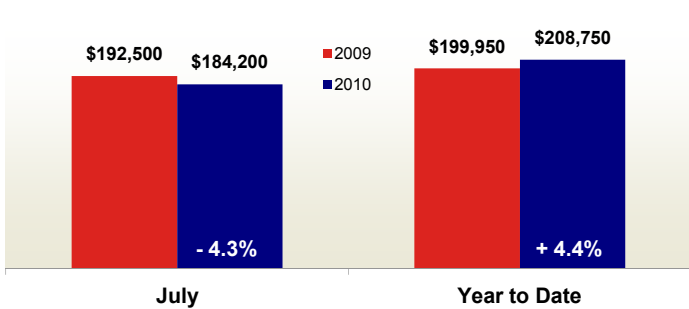
### Activity—Most Recent Month



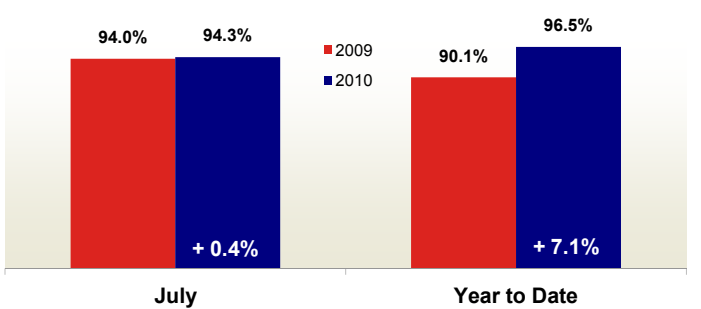
### Activity—Year to Date



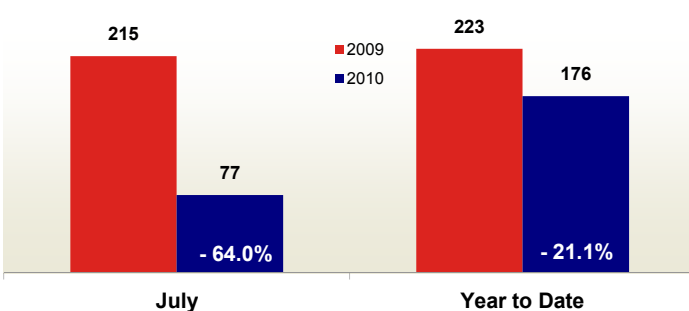
### Median Sales Price



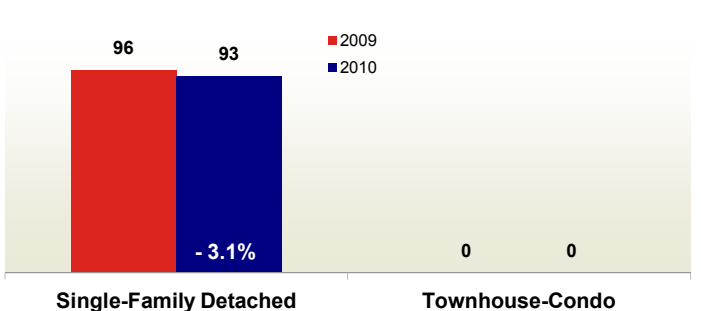
### Percent of Original List Price Received
