

# State Fair Booth Expectations

There must be at least one person in the booth at all times. Booth Leads are responsible for ensuring there is at least one person in the booth, and that volunteers are following the rules of the State Fair.

Wear the t-shirt provided as it promotes a unified look and message to fairgoers. Shorts are acceptable as it may be warm in the building.

Feel free to wear your personalized/branded name badge.

MAR will provide a spin-the-wheel with small giveaway items. If you bring your own branded giveaway items, please make sure to take all remaining items with you at the end of your shift. Do not leave them on the table for someone else to clean up after you. Volunteers are not allowed to bring large items, drawings or spin-the-wheels.

## Approved list of giveaways to bring:

- Pens
- Magnets
- Notepads
- Keychains
- Flashlights
- Tattoos

Bring business cards to hand out. Volunteers are responsible for collecting their own leads' contact information. Contact info sheets will be provided for you that you can take with you at the end of your shift. MAR is not providing devices for volunteer use this year. Please bring your own device.

Agents **MUST** have contacts sign an Agency Form before any discussion of the home value is discussed. Agents are responsible for printing and following all rules of Agency.

DO NOT have any commission or fee-based conversations. If asked, please use that as an opportunity to contact them on a later date.

T-shirts, water and pens are for volunteers use only. Please do not give these items away to the public.

No consumption of alcohol before your shift. Please change out of your volunteer shirt if you plan to enjoy the fair after your shift.
