What are the most important housing challenges facing your community?

The Twin Cities Metro is facing a housing shortage unlike any we have experienced in recent history. What will you do to increase the number of homes available to residents of your community?

Wev have inplemented many housing iniitatives including inclusion clauses for work force/ affordale housing requirements that need to be met on all projects presented to us on the City Council. We have issued waivers as needed that make sense on lot size requirements to make new properties as affordable as possible as needed. We have implemented a housing task force, which I had a part in to advise us on new ways expand our focus of accommodating the need for more housing opportunities. The message we send whenever possib8le is for them is to "think beyond the box!" and we will listen.

Minnesota has one of the largest homeownership gaps between Whites and Blacks, Indigenous, and People of Color. This is one of MAR's primary concerns. What would you propose at the local level to close this home ownership gap?

I'm aware that the gap is large and getting worse. I believe we need to continue to use all of our resources to continue to ramp up home ownership opportunities. This may be through expanding our knowledge of using leasehold or land trust instruments to assist in financing. I would also like to see our HRA which I'm a member of be utilized in a broader scope going forward and to continue to think "beyond the box." This was one of the pillars that i was initially elected on with strong interaction with our large local Somali population in Eden Prairie. We need to keep think and fighting change whenever possible!

How do you think the city can best balance the rights of tenants and property owners to effectively manage rental housing?

I personally work closely with our residents regarding tenants and property owners whenever needed and called upon. We are a city expect everyone to be treated with respect and dignity and will tolerate nothing less!

What are your views on property tax rates in your community? Do you have concerns related to the city's property tax rate? If so, how would you address those concerns once elected?

Our property taxes (city portion), are one of the lowest in the metro area. We always try to balance our levy to maintain the balance between our FIRST-RATE city services/ first responders and our residents' expectations. We have a high respect for spending the tax \$\$ and maintaining our high Bond rating!!!! Which is, one of the highest in the state!!
